**Motion**: "That the Minutes of the AGM held August 2024 be noted as a true and correct record of the meeting"

#### REPORTS AND ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

#### Bank account authority

The bank account authority must be reviewed and voted on at the AGM

**Motion**: "That all signatures to the Club bank accounts and term deposits, held with Bank of Queensland (BoQ) be removed.

The incoming President, Treasurer, Secretary, Vice President be appointed as signatories to all accounts with BoQ for deposits and withdrawals.

The authority being two signatures for a withdrawal and one for a standard deposit or term deposit."

#### **RESOLVED**

#### Public/Legal liability insurance

The management committee is required to consider annually the need for public/legal liability insurance and report its decision to the AGM. The secretary presented the following motion.

**Motion**: "The meeting notes that insurance for general liability insurance coverage of \$10 million is in place and will be renewed on 1 December 2025. The current broker is Network Insurance Group, and the insurer is Sportscover Australia Pty Ltd. ABN: 44 055 489 088.

The treasurer has authority to renewal coverage, including increases to the coverage"

Motion: "That the management committee for 2025/26 year comprise of: President – Phill Price, Secretary – Michael Jacobson, Treasurer – Paul Mc Guire, Vice President – Craig Humprey, and commence in these roles from 1 October 2025"

#### RESOLVED

#### **Awarding Life Membership**

President Phill Price outlined the work that Helen and Michael Gavigan had done for the Club over many years and informed the meeting that the Management Committee has awarded life membership in recognition of their dedication to the Club.

#### Non-management committee positions

Ride group coordinators, social media management, website management, and other support positions will be determined by the 2025/26 Management Committee.

RESOLVED

For a special resolution to pass it will need 75% of the vote from members who are present and entitled to vote. The voting process used a paper ballot.

The President appointed the Secretary as acting chairperson for this item on the agenda.

# Proposed club name change

A presentation was made by the President on the proposal to change the Club name. Following the presentation, members were asked to vote to determine if there was enough support for presenting a formal motion for a change of name.

Returning Officers Helen Gavigan and Paul Glass were appointed to count ballot-paper votes.

## Voting options and results:

1. No change in name. 7 votes

2. Sunshine Coast Bicycle Club Inc. 34 votes (76%)

3. Bicycle Sunshine Coast Club Inc. 4 votes

Total number of votes cast was 45. Percentage of votes in support option 2 exceeds 75%

As there was support for a new name and *Sunshine Coast Bicycle Club Inc* was the preferred option the Secretary presented the motion.

1. Motion/resolution. "That the name Sunshine Coast Bicycle Touring Club Incorporated, be changed and replaced with Sunshine Coast Bicycle Club Incorporated.

The Secretary asked for speakers for and against the motion to present their views to the meeting. Members were asked to vote by a show of hands, counting was undertaken by the Returning Officers.

The Secretary explained the next steps to change the name included lodging an application form for a name change and paying the required fee to the Office of Fair-Trading QLD.

- Bicycling Sunshine Coast Club Incorporated.
